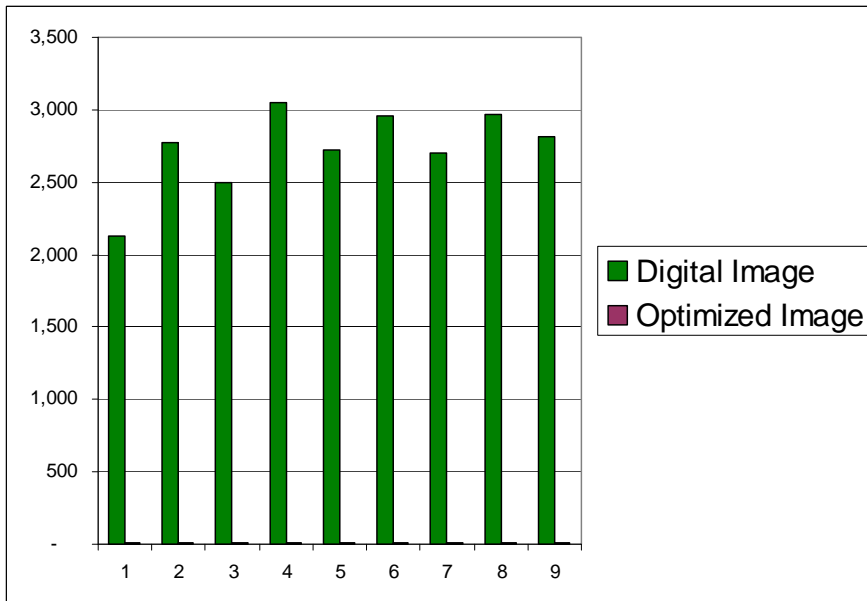


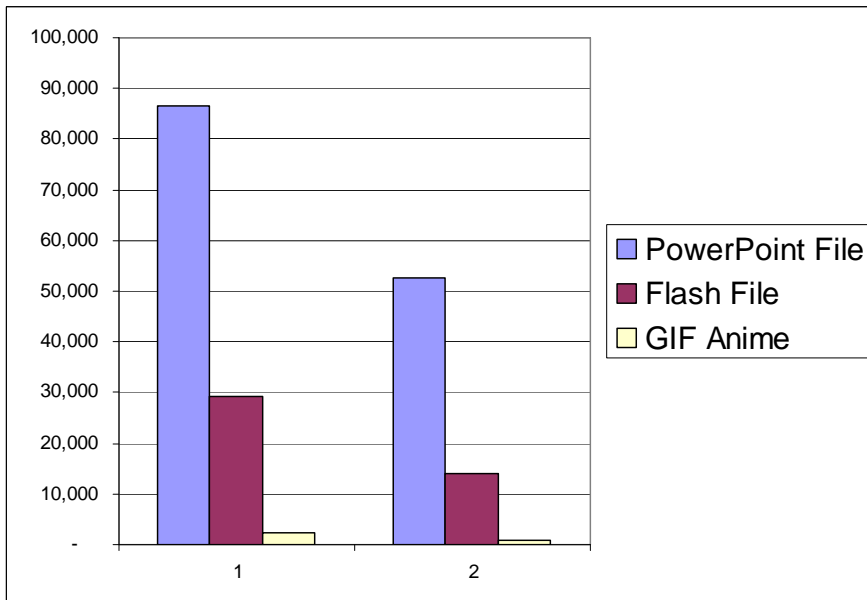
What is the deal about image size?

Optimization: Photos brought into PowerPoint can be resized to fit the page by clicking and dragging the mouse. But PowerPoint is not reducing the size of the image, just the appearance of it. – When resizing an image in an image editor colors and pixels are calculated to reduce the dimensions and bulk of the file while retaining quality. Pixels are reduced, and color information is reused, not duplicated, throughout the image. A much smaller file is the result. See the charts below (measured in kilobytes) to learn what a significant difference using an image editor can make.
